The CPP also offers a two-day working session workshop focused on the Benefits of a Conservation Plan, setting goals and objectives, identifying natural resource concerns, developing maps of operation to develop a comprehensive soil/vegetation report, and developing management plans (Livestock, Ranch, and Farm). Lastly, CPP also offers an informational presentation for Grazing Committees, Farm Boards, Chapter Officials, or others.
